The Medical Counseling, Organizing, and Recruiting program (Med-COR) seeks to increase the pool of high school students of color committed to the pursuit of health professional careers. The program aims to support students from disadvantaged backgrounds and prepare them academically to be competitive for admission to colleges and universities nationwide. Through education and co-curricular experiences, Med-COR encourages and motivates students to commit themselves to careers in health.



Program Highlights:

- Academic tutoring and support in science, math, and English
- 20 Saturday tutoring sessions during the academic year, held on USC's University Park Campus
- Guidance on the college application process and SAT prep
- Guest speakers, workshops, and medical and health-related activities throughout the year, including a health professions Career Day
- Mentoring from graduate students enrolled in USC's health profession programs: medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, physician assistant, physical therapy, and occupational therapy
- Summer clinical internship program at USC/Keck-affiliated hospitals
